2. Is a civil litigator who has trial and/or arbitration experience and has participated in mediations.

4. Will submit a personal statement of up to 1,000 words that showcases their motivation for pursuing this scholarship, overview of their career goals, and how this scholarship will help them make a positive impact on society.
5. Will submit a letter of recommendation from an officer or board member in the bar group in which they serve.

A selection committee, comprised of accomplished ADR professionals from various backgrounds, will meticulously review applications and select the winning candidate. Applicants are required to submit their resume reflecting the experience mentioned above along with their personal statement, and letter of recommendation.
